

Miele WASH CYCLE TEMPERATURES AT-A-GLANCE

Reference points for water temperature are in brackets

Sanitize.....**158 F/70C**.....[an egg begins to cook at 160F]
Hot.....**140 F/60C**.....[optimal hot setting for whites]
Very Warm..**122F/50C**.....[just above warm water to proof yeast]
Warm.....**104 F/ 40C**.....[lukewarm/temperature of a high fever]
Cold.....**86F/30C**.....[just below body temperature]
No Heat.....**Variable**.....[house tap temp; seasonal]

Note: An instant-read yeast/meat thermometer inserted into the main detergent cup at the start of a cycle will provide an indication of cold and hot water fill temperatures. These will vary according to the house and may change seasonally in some climates. 130F/55C is suggested as the ideal hot water tap temperature and Miele cautions that hot water should not exceed 140F/60C at the tap.
